EXPRESSJET ADDS NON-STOP FLIGHT TO TUCSON

Houston, August 13, 2007—Earlier this summer, ExpressJet Airlines introduced non-stop flights to Southern California from El Paso International Airport. XE 119, departs 8:25 AM, arrives 10:30 AM

Customers traveling to Tucson can also continue to Los Angeles/Ontario International Airport (ONT) or take advantage of ExpressJet’s non-stop flight to Los Angeles/Ontario International Airport.
