### **Purpose**

Tucson Airport Authority has initiated a performing arts program, *Live at TIA*, for individuals or groups to provide a cultural experience for our traveling public, meeters/greeters and employees at the Tucson International Airport. Compensation for performances may not always be available.

Designated areas have been selected in the main terminal as performance locations and include: the Center Pointe, located at the center core of the ticketing level between Southwest and Delta ticket counters; throughout the baggage claim area on the lower level; and the upper level at the entrance to the Link moving sidewalk to the rental car facility. Other locations are available as appropriate for the group and occasion.

### **Eligibility**

Eligibility is limited to professional performers living in the airport's trade area: Pima, Pinal, Cochise, Santa Cruz Counties in Arizona and Sonora, Mexico. Group size is a consideration.

### **Application Process**

Performers and groups wishing to participate may request an application form by phone or mail to the Tucson Airport Authority, 7005 South Plumer Avenue Tucson, Arizona 85756, Attention Performing Arts Program, 573-8187, or via email at [art@tucsonairport.org](mailto:art@tucsonairport.org). ### **Review Process**

Submissions will be reviewed by Arts and Culture at the Airport staff. The airport reserves the right to approve or reject any submission for review. Repertoire must be appropriate for the airport's public audience. All types of music are encouraged. Groups may be limited by space constraints.

Those selected for Live at TIA may be required to submit written materials (statement/background) that will be used to promote the performance. The airport may require submission of a description of the performance and musical selections. The airport will arrange scheduling for the approved performance.

### **Set Up and Tear Down**

Performers are responsible for bringing, setting up and removing their own equipment. Advance approval is required for all promotional material. The Airport will not act as an agent for any performers.
